## ***Tagus Creek Shiraz & Touriga Nacional 2009***

<b>Denomination</b>	Vinho Regional Tejo
<b>Type</b>	Rosé wine
<b>Grape varieties</b>	Shiraz and Touriga Nacional
<b>Region</b>	Tejo
<b>Soil</b>	Poor and Sandy
<b>Harvest</b>	By hand to small cases of 15 kg
<b>Vinification</b>	After cold maceration, grapes are pressed and fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, with temperature control at aprox 16°C.
<b>Alcohol</b>	13 % vol.
<b>Total acidity</b>	6 g/l
<b>Residual sugar</b>	< 4 g/l
<b>Tasting notes</b>	“Pretty pink” vibrant rose colour. This wine has an elegant bouquet of fresh strawberries and raspberries and a hint of dried herbs. A more serious and fresh style of rose with a crisp yet smooth palate that unlike many rose wines finishes quite dry leaving you with want for another mouthful. Given this is a drier style of rose it is a great barbeque wine either by itself or with salmon, chicken and any number of fresh salads.
